The accelerated efforts from your end regarding delivery of promotional materials & effective planning & implementations of health camps in Refusal and Sick cluster pockets has lead to huge reduction of Unvaccinated cohort.

This has lead to a decrease in vaccine avoidance behaviour & an increase in community confidence on Vaccines.
